Commonly thought of as a water-rich state, Washington's freshwater is at risk from overuse, climate change, and increasing demand. Rivers and streams need water year-round to support thriving salmon populations and communities.

Invest in water solutions that work

WWT keeps rivers flowing year-round using collaborative market-based solutions, including:

- Water rights assessments and acquisition
- Groundwater mitigation and water banking
- Irrigation source switches and efficiencies
- Special drought-year conservation initiatives
- Sustainable alternative water sources

WWT projects have restored 5.7 billion gallons of water to more than 1,000 river miles across Washington.

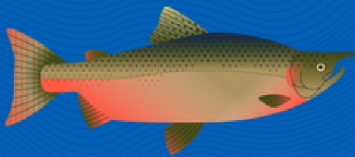

Chinook Level

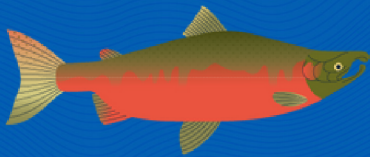

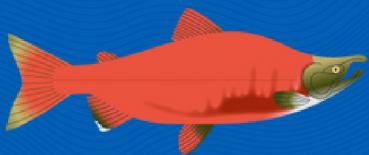
